

# BEST OF SOUTHERN AFRICA

Experience four of the major highlights southern Africa has to offer. Explore Cape Town, the 'Mother City' and the world renowned Kruger National Park, home to Africa's iconic safari species. See one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World, the magnificent Victoria Falls, and enjoy Botswana's Chobe National Park, famed for its vast elephant herds and diverse landscape.

## **Days 1 & 2: Cape Town**

Welcome to Cape Town! Transfer to your hotel for two nights. Cape Town offers a winning combination of beautiful coastal scenery and urban sophistication. This evening explore the vibrant Victoria & Alfred Waterfront at leisure. The next day, explore famous landmarks including Table Mountain (weather-permitting), and the colourful Malay Quarter of Bo-Kaap.

## **Day 3: Cape Peninsula**

Enjoy a full-day excursion to the beautiful Cape Peninsula. A scenic drive along the Atlantic coast passes through the cosmopolitan suburbs of Sea Point and Camps Bay with glorious views of the Twelve Apostles, part of the Table Mountain range. Further on, the Cape Point Nature Reserve offers a wealth of fauna and flora. End at the beautiful Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens.



## **Days 4 - 6: Cape Town > Greater Kruger Area**

After breakfast, fly to Kruger and transfer to your private safari lodge for a three-day safari. The Greater Kruger area is made up of various private game reserves that form an unfenced protected wilderness area adjacent to Kruger National Park. Enjoy thrilling wildlife encounters on morning and evening game drives with expert guides.

## **Days 7 & 8: Greater Kruger Area > Victoria Falls Zimbabwe**

Enjoy an early game drive before breakfast then fly to Victoria Falls. Check in to your accommodation then head out to discover why Victoria Falls is one of the seven Natural Wonders of the World. On the Zimbabwean side there are numerous spectacular vantage points along the width of the Falls where this astounding sight simply takes your breath away.

## **Day 9: Victoria Falls > Kasane > Chobe National Park**

Transfer to your lodge in Chobe National Park, Botswana, one of the greatest wildlife destinations in Africa, famed for its elephants. On game drives, you may also see





many other species including waterbuck, lechwe, giraffe, kudu, sable, impala, warthog, bushbuck, monkeys and baboons, along with the accompanying predators – lion, leopard, hyena and jackal.

#### Days 10 & 11: Chobe National Park

Spend time at leisure enjoying the activities included in your stay (activities vary per lodge). Or simply take time to just relax and soak in the nature and your beautiful lodge.

#### Day 12: Chobe National Park > Kasane

Today you will be collected from your lodge and transferred to Kasane Airport, where arrangements conclude.
