SMALL SHIP CRUISING

Small-ship cruising in Alaska offers an intimate way to explore Glacier Bay and the Inside Passage, reaching remote waterways inaccessible to larger ships. Zodiac excursions, kayaking, and hiking provide close-up encounters with glaciers, whales, dolphins, and other wildlife.



CANADA ITINERARIES

Canada is a year-round destination, known for its towering mountains, vast forests, remote coastlines, and incredible wildlife viewing. The spring and summer seasons (May to mid-September) are ideal for bear viewing – enjoy a quiet stay in a remote bear viewing lodge or journey through the Rockies onboard the famous Rocky Mountaineer train. Late September/October, the East Coast in particular has the most spectacular fall colours.

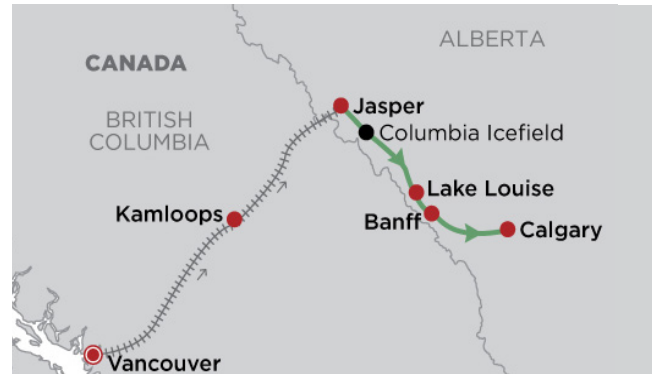


SELF-DRIVE

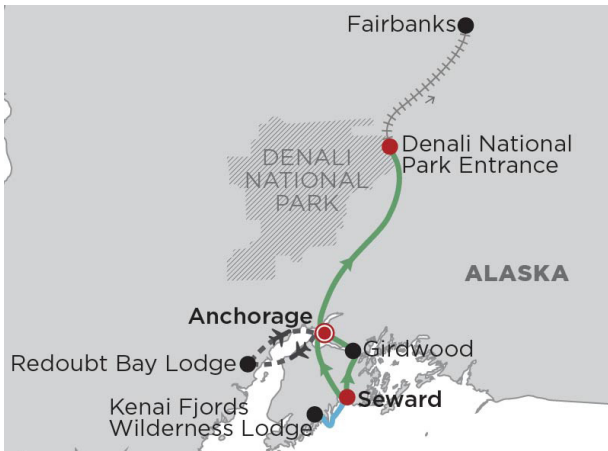
POLAR BEARS AT TUNDRA BUGGY LODGE | 7 DAYS

ALASKA ITINERARIES

Alaska's fjords and sheltered inlets are best explored by small-ship cruise, offering close-up views of glaciers, icebergs, and incredible wildlife including whales, grizzlies, moose, and wolves. Cruising the northern Inside Passage allows access to remote ports and untouched wilderness that larger ships can't reach. Cruises run from May to September, while the winter months from September to April are ideal for spotting the magical Northern Lights.



TAILOR-MADE

HIGHLIGHTS OF KENAI FJORDS & DENALI 9 DAYS

Fly by floatplane from Anchorage for opportunities to view black and brown bears. Explore the rugged landscapes of Girdwood before cruising through Kenai Fjords National Park. Continue to Denali National Park, home to bears, moose and caribou, before travelling to Fairbanks on the Alaska Railroad's Denali Star. (Season: May – Sep)
