### **LIFE ONBOARD**

Each train has accommodation carriages, dining cars, a lounge car, small gift shop, smoking lounge and observation car with open-air balcony. The lounge and observation cars make for great mingling areas. Maintaining the spirit of a bygone era, there are no radios or televisions on board.
