Neutral coloured clothing is recommended, we advise against wearing camouflage, bright colours, or white clothing while on safari.

Luggage Limitations

Generally, any safari whether by air or by land, will have restrictions on the type and size of luggage that you will be able to bring. This ranges from 15—20kg (including hand luggage) depending on the country/ safari and must be packed in a soft, malleable bag. Hard cases or hard-based suitcases are not accepted.
