THE TRAIN:

Rovos Rail has earned an international reputation for its truly world-class travel experiences. The beautifully rebuilt wood-panelled trains each carry a maximum of 72 passengers in 36 superbly appointed suites. Dining cars, a lounge car and observation car with open-air balcony provide convivial social spaces.



THE SUITES:

Vintage carriages combine with modern luxuries in three suite types available in double or twin. All suites feature private bathrooms, a fridge, tea facilities, safes, air conditioning and luggage storage. Pullman Suites feature a sofa which converts to a bed for the evening. Deluxe Suites have their own lounge area and permanent bed. ITINERARY

Day 1: Pretoria

Depart late afternoon on the eastern line and settle into your suite.

Day 2: Day at leisure on board

Pass through rolling hills and descend the Drakensberg Mountain escarpment as you head towards Malelane & Kruger National Park.

Day 3: Kruger National Park or White River

Golfers transfer to White River Country Club or Nelspruit for tee off, while others enjoy a wildlife game drive in the National Park.

Day 4: Eswatini or Nkonyeni / Royal Swazi

Travel through the mountain Kingdom of Eswatini, witnessing traditional life and artisan crafts. Golfing today is at Knonyeni or Royal Swazi.

Day 5: Hluhluwe-Imfolozi Park

Enjoy thrilling wildlife encounters in Hluhluwe.

Day 6: Durban

Golfers enjoy Durban Beachwood or Durban Country Club as others explore the city, botanical gardens and the beachfront. The train then traverses the Valley of a Thousand Hills.

Day 8: Golden Gate National Park or Clarens

Drive through the stunning National Park, visit the picturesque town of Clarens, and the Sandstone Heritage Trust.

Day 9: Bloemfontein

Home of the country's judicial system, Bloemfontein offers fascinating history. Later traverse the aridly beautiful Karoo.

Day 10: Addo Elephant Park or Humewood

Golfers transfer to Humewood for tee off, as others enjoy a game drive through Addo Elephant Park.

Day 11: Knysna or Pezula / Simola > Fancourt

Golfers transfer to Pezul or Simola for tee off. Others head for Knysna for a lagoon ferry ride. After lunch the train travels the famed Garden Route along the coast. Dinner and overnight is at Fancourt

Day 12: Oudsthoorn or Fancourt

Golfers tee off at Fancourt, which is home to three Gary Player designer courses, each with its own unique character and allure. Meanwhile, non-golfers visit an ostrich farm, then this afternoon, all visit the incredible Cango Caves.

Day 13: Cape Town

As breakfast is served the train trundles through spectacular mountain ranges and scenic winelands of the Western Cape. Your journey ends in Cape Town after lunch.
