Just nine ensuite safari tents luxuriously combine canvas, soft drapes and bleached timber – you'll love the romantic outdoor sala, private plunge pool, indoor bathtub and al fresco shower.

andBeyond Sandibe Okavango Safari Lodge

Private "Big Five" wilderness concession bordering Moremi Game Reserve. Best wildlife viewing with truly spectacular accommodation and service. The inspired design of the lodge melts into the surrounding forest canopy of wild palms and gnarled fig trees.

andBeyond Nxabega Okavango Delta Tented Camp

Located on an exclusive 25,000-hectare wildlife concession bordering the Moremi Game Reserve, the camp is known for its elegant tented accommodation, which boasts breathtaking views of both mature mopane woodlands and seasonally flooded grasslands. SAMPLE ITINERARY

Day 1: Maun > Okavango Delta

You will be met and transferred to andBeyond Xaranna Okavango Delta Camp for three nights. This pristine wetland area is brimming with abundant wildlife.

Days 2 – 3: Okavango Delta

The Delta is home to a large number of species, including some specially-adapted semi-aquatic creatures, such as the elegant red lechwe and shy sitatunga antelope. Wild cat, serval and pangolin can also be spotted at night. Game drives in open 4x4 vehicles, by mokoro (dugout canoe) or motor boats and on foot provide thrilling wildlife encounters. Bird watching, bush breakfasts and sundowners

in spectacular natural surroundings are among unexpected highlights. This is African hospitality at its best.

Days 4 - 5: Okavango Delta

Light aircraft or helicopter flight to andBeyond Sandibe Okavango Safari Lodges for three nights. The beautiful architecture of the lodge and its 12 suites blends seamlessly with breathtaking landscapes. With traversing rights over a vast 22,500 hectares, you will enjoy iconic wildlife sightings on foot and by vehicle, with expert guides and rangers.

Day 6: Okavango Delta > Maun

On your final day you will transfer to Maun Airport for your onward flight.
